

What is PPNLSHC?

Planned Parenthood NLSHC is a non-profit charitable organization that promotes positive sexual health for all and the social determinants of health for 2SLGBTQIA+ individuals through education, community partnership, information, and services within an environment that supports and respects individual choice

Our services are available to anyone regardless of age, race, ethnicity, gender, gender identity, gender expression, socioeconomic status, physical or mental ability, sexual orientation, religion, religious creed, national or social origin, marital status, family status and political opinion.

Sexual & Reproductive Health Clinics

We generally have medical clinics are offered Monday - Friday by appointment only. Anyone can call and book an appointment without a referral. Waitlists can be lengthy, but we will do our best to work with your needs, expect a minimum wait of 1-2 weeks. All doctors are up to date on procedures and informed care practices. All appointments are confidential, and non-judgmental.

Clinic Services

Services of these clinics include, but are not limited to:

- Pap Tests
- STI Testing & Treatment
- Emergency Contraception
- Birth Control Prescriptions
- Post TA Exams
- Referrals
- IUD and Nexplanon Inserts
- Breast and Vaginal exams
- Penile and testicular exams

Drop-In Services

Pregnancy Testing & Support:

Anyone can drop in during our regular hours and complete or pick up a urine pregnancy test. These are the same tests used in hospitals, and we provide them for no cost (but donations are welcome).

Our staff and volunteers provide accurate, supportive options counselling for any individual who finds out they are pregnant. We are a pro-choice clinic and provide information and referrals based on an individual's choice.

Peer Support:

Anyone can drop in or call anytime during our business hours for peer support for any sexual or reproductive healthcare issue, 2SLGBTQIA+ issues, or harm reduction based information

Harm Reduction Saturdays

We are open on Saturdays for our drop-in services, including:

- picking up supplies
- picking up requisitions and/ or giving a urine sample
- booking appointments
- pregnancy testing
- purchasing emergency contraception

Educational Presentations

We offer various workshops in person and virtually through schools, community centres, workplaces, etc., including a 12-week Teen and Adult Healthy Relationships and service provider training like Queering the Compass.
